

Apalachicola-Chattahoochee-Flint Rivers Waterway

The Apalachicola, Chattahoochee, and Flint River system (ACF) is managed by the US Army Corps of Engineers. The ACF extends approximately 385 miles from northeast Georgia to the Gulf of Mexico. The total drainage area of this basin is about 19,600 square miles.

Corps of Engineers operated dams and lakes in the ACF system include:

- Buford Dam and Lake Lanier
- West Point Dam and Lake
- W.F. George Lock and Dam, and Lake Eufaula
- George W. Andrews Lock and Dam and Lake
- Jim Woodruff Lock and Dam and Lake Seminole

The ACF also includes several smaller private dams and reservoirs operated by public utilities and corporations.
